RE: Early Intervention Distribution of KN95 Face Masks

As previously mentioned in several Early Intervention (EI) Weekly Updates, the Bureau was able to procure a good supply of KN95 face masks for distribution to any EI Payee for their staff who would request them. The masks will be delivered to the EI Payee for distribution to their staff members. The number of masks will depend on the number of staff and EI Payees enrolled as well as the overall number of available masks.

The Bureau was able to obtain a rather large supply and is hoping to provide enough masks to last several weeks for each EI Payee who submits a request.
