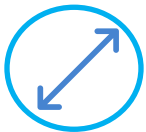




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SSIP Phase 3 Quarterly Summary

Scale-Up

Our five new CFCs (2, 5, 6, 23, and 24) are up and running! Leadership Teams have been busy raising awareness of their efforts and working on creating buy in from their local stakeholders. Monitoring and Training supports have been getting to know their teams and providing input and support when needed. Teams continue working on their action plans and determining how to build capacity around the child outcomes summary process in their local areas.



Child Outcomes Analysis

We are still engaged with some technical assistance partners from the Center for IDEA Early Childhood Data Systems (DaSy) to help us look at child outcomes accuracy. We are looking at trends in statewide and Child and Family Connections data. We have also been looking at entry rating trends and how they correlate with our SSIP activities. They are also helping us determine how the Child Outcomes Summary Knowledge Check (COS-KC) might support our SSIP efforts.



Partners

We are still trying to determine when the next Large SSIP Stakeholder workgroup convening will be held. We plan to use that time to discuss current activities, plans for addressing our family engagement strategy, and potential next steps for the child outcomes and family engagement work. State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) updates to the broader field continue to be provided in Partners' newsletters.
